### SOUTH CAROLINA DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES

It is the intent of the South Carolina Department of Social Services (DSS) to issue a sole source procurement to Northrop Grumman System Corporation for the development and implementation of a suite of web-based applications designed to enhance the administration, management, and oversight of the Child & Adult Care Food Program.
