The New Bioengineering Research Building will be a sustainable building designed to a minimum of LEED Silver Level certification. The building will be approximately 90,000 GSF (including penthouse, mechanical space, & site improvements) & has a budget range of \$35-\$45M construction cost. The building will be primarily intense wet laboratory space with shared equipment rooms & offices for the faculty / researchers. There will also be vivarium, assembly, classroom, administration, & associated support spaces. Utilities will be provided by connection to existing underground distribution systems.

The University Has Contracted with Stevens & Wilkinson Architects to provide design services.

The University Intends To Engage the successful construction management firm for preconstruction services with the additional intent of engaging the construction management firm for construction services provided the University & the Construction

Management firm can agree on a fair & reasonable fee & GMP.

We Have An Aggressive Design & Construction Schedule & a limited budget. We selected Stevens & Wilkinson Architects to design the building in December 2007. Programming for the building began in February 2008. We intend to get a Construction Manager at Risk on board as early in the preconstruction services phase as possible. Building construction is expected to start in the early spring of 2009 & to be substantially completed by late summer of 2010. Early construction packages may be used to accelerate the construction schedule

The Medical University Of South Carolina embraces diversity including use of minority businesses, vendors, or contractors in construction projects. Candidates will be required to submit a detailed plan in their proposal to implement this as part of the Construction Manager at Risk services.
