NOTICE TO ALL CONSULTING ENGINEERING FIRMS

The South Carolina Department of Transportation (SCDOT) requests a letter of interest & qualifications from firms experienced in providing Work Zone Intelligent Transportation Systems (WZITS). These services shall include the design, implementation & operation of the WZITS in various construction projects.

The providers of these services shall be involved in the initial design of the work zone traffic control.

After design, the vendor shall be responsible for coordinating the installation, maintenance & operation of the designed devices for each project. The vendor should also include a public web site so that the work zone activities can be monitored by the motoring public.

The work will be performed under a three-year on-call contract. The work will be statewide & performed on an as needed basis. The SCDOT may select more than one firm to perform this work.

In consultant selection, the SCDOT will consider & conduct a comparative ranking of the firms submitting based upon the following: experience, qualifications, & technical competence of the staff proposed for the type of work required (25%); past performance of the proposing firm & subconsultants proposed on similar type projects and/or ability to perform all aspects of services (20%); past performance in utilizing DBEs (5%); familiarity of proposed staff with SCDOT practices & procedures (15%); availability of key staff & the ability to mobilize quickly & meet project schedules (25%); DBE utilization plan (5%); & current volume of work with SCDOT (5%). Each proposal is required to indicate the amount of work expected to be paid, on a percentage basis, to each firm identified as providing a service in the proposal.

The SCDOT selection will be based on information submitted; however, additional information and/or an interview may be required.

All unmarked pages will be subject to release in accordance with law. Proposer should be prepared, upon request, to provide justification of why such materials should not be disclosed under the SC Freedom of Information Act, S.C. Code Section 30-4-10, et seq.

Consultants shall comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964. The SCDOT strongly encourages the use of & involvement of Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBE) on this project.
