Chester County, SC has received a grant from the South Carolina Department of Transportation (SCDOT) under the Transportation Enhancement Program. The grant will assist in the construction of sidewalks to improve community access in the Gayle Mill Village of the County. Activities approved for the project include removal of sidewalk, construction of approximately 3400 linear feet of ADA-compliant sidewalk on Backgate, Pryor, White, Winston & Sweeney Streets, curb & gutter replacement, & traffic management & safety controls. The South Carolina Hydrogen & Fuel Cell Alliance (SCHFCA) & its members hereby solicit proposals from interested persons or organizations for the expressed purpose of selecting a theme & site location for the 2007–2008 H2U Student Design Contest. The H2U Student Design Contest aims to create a competitive forum for students studying a variety of disciplines to apply their academic learning & creativity in the areas of design, engineering, economics, environmental science, & business & marketing to the development of a hydrogen economy.

Proposed sites must be located in South Carolina, & the deadline for proposal submission is October 27, 2006.
