SCOPE OF WORK

The construction effort can be generally described as the rehabilitation of the main entrance road and parking lot. More specifically, this will involve variable-depth asphalt milling and placement of SCDOT Type CM asphalt over existing asphalt as well as over exiting base course. In addition, a portion of the project consists of reconstructing a short, asphalt-paved access driveway to the airfield with concrete. Associated work items consist of construction of a staging area, limited erosion control measures, pavement marking, installation of detector loops in concrete pavement and connection to the airfield access control system, and protection of existing monitoring wells in the work area.

CONTRACT TIME

Contract time will be 30 contract days (60 consecutive calendar days) from the date of Notice-to-Proceed and within the prescribed phasing in Section 01010 of the Project Manual.

The South Carolina State Election Commission (SEC) is seeking a vendor to scan voter registration lists from the 2016 Statewide Republican and Democratic Primary. The selected vendor will scan the voter registration lists and provide the SEC with a text file of voters who voted in the Statewide Primary.

- Images of list are not required (images of exceptions, unreadable marks, missing information, or manual determinations will be emailed to SEC staff for evaluation of voter intent).
- The list consists of approximately one hundred thousand (100,000) duplex pages with thirty (30) voters to a page from forty-six (46) counties
- Voter registration lists will be shipped via USPS, FedEx or other approved shipper (or delivered by SEC courier depending on vendor location). SEC will provide tracking number for shipments.
- Barcodes on the paper list identify the voter by voter registration number
- Filled ovals identify the voter's choice of party
- Filled ovals identify the voter's participation for the Primary and/or the Runoff
- All information in the list is consider public information in the State of South Carolina
- Some counties use an electronic poll book. There will not be any data to return for those counties.
- Copies of the Voter Registration List and the required text file can be obtained from the SEC.

Requirements:

Return of paper list to the SEC for archival is required (vendor will return scanned voter registration list via USPS, FedEx or other approved shipper (or delivered by the vendors courier depending on vendor location). Vendor must provide tracking number for shipments.

Vendor will provide one text file from each county containing the following

- County Number (a list of county numbers will be provided)
- Voter Registration Number (obtained from barcode)
- Party Choice (obtained from filled oval)
